A word about the schedule...

- Practices will be held one day/week, on Mondays from 6:30-9pm at the CT Sports Center in Woodbridge.
- Tournaments require travel on weekends (Saturday or Sunday). The tournament schedule will be determined by the New England Region. All tournaments will only be one day events.
- There will be an extra cost *only* if the teams decide to travel to any additional tournaments, other than the regular NERVA tournament series (i.e. Penn State, NE Winterfest, or Rochester).
- Players are responsible for their own hotels (if necessary) and transportation to all practices and tournaments.

Program Info Grades 9-12

Cost: \$525 (plus \$40 NERVA registration fee)

- * All boys, with at least one year of experience, in grades 9-12 are invited to tryout
- * **Tryouts will be held on Mondays, November 15 & 22, 6:30-9pm at the CT Sports Center. We will do our best to keep as many players as we can.**
- * **There is a \$40 NERVA fee that is nonrefundable and does not count towards the regular tuition.**
- * Teams will be made up of 10-12 players based on age and ability
- * **Registration deadline is Wednesday, November 10th**

About CT Juniors Tuition

- The CJVA is member-supported. Tuition goes toward operating expenses including uniforms, insurance, custodial fees, facility rentals, coach's salaries, and administrative expenses.
- **Teams will be formed by the end of the 2nd tryout. Any players that are not placed on a team will be refunded, less a \$40 tryout fee. Players have the option of paying the entire tuition of \$525 when registering, or by paying in two installments of \$270, one due when registering, and the other due on Jan 15, 2011. (Please note that if paying in installments, total program cost is \$540)**
- Once teams are formed, refunds will be granted on a prorated basis, for medical reasons only, and with a doctor's note of explanation.
- ***When registering, players must include the \$40 membership fee for NERVA, a division of USA Volleyball, which will then be paid by CT Juniors.***
