## Travel Teams

### Grades 7-12

Cost \$1850

The CT Juniors has one of the most respected travel programs in the east. Many Travel Program players have received college scholarships. Teams of 10-12 players will be formed in the following age groups: 18 and Under, 17 and Under, 16 and Under and 15 and Under. The cost includes an average of two practices per week, uniforms, warm-ups, coaches salaries and expenses, USAV membership and tourney entry fees. It does not include hotels or food. Practices will be held on Sundays and Wednesdays. Tryouts are Monday, December 1st and Wednesday, December 3rd from 6:00-9:00 pm and Saturday, December 6th from noon - 3 pm. There is a \$60 tryout fee that is nonrefundable. The season runs from December to May. Teams will be formed by the end of the 3rd tryout and players will be required to pay for the program immediately following the 3rd tryout. Players have the option of paying the entire tuition of \$1850 on December 6th or by paying installments of \$900 on December 6th and \$500 due January 15th and February 15th. Players not making the Travel Program can still play in the State Program. Travel teams will also participate in at least one club fundraiser during the season.

## State Program

### Grades 8-12

Cost: \$495

For players who have played organized middle school, Freshman, J.V., or Varsity volleyball. Tryouts are December 7, 14 & 21. Teams of 9-11 players will be formed based on age and ability. Teams will practice and compete in tournaments against other teams from around the state. Players not selected to a team will be notified after the 3rd tryout and refunded less a \$90 tryout fee. Eighth graders and Freshman not selected to the State Program will have the opportunity to participate in the Developmental Program. State Program players should refer to the schedule and practice locations on the back of this brochure. Registration deadline is December 3rd or when all tryout facilities are at capacity.

### About CT Juniors Tuition

The CJVA is member supported. Tuition goes toward operating expenses including uniforms, insurance, facility rentals, custodial fees, coaches salaries and administrative expenses.

State players have the option of paying the entire \$495 tuition all at once when registering or in 2 installments of \$260. The first installment is due when registering and the second is due at the first tournament.

Refunds less a \$20 processing fee will be granted prior to the registration deadline of Wednesday, December 3rd. After that, refunds will be granted less a \$60 processing fee. Once tryouts start, refunds will be granted on a prorated basis for medical reasons only with a doctor's explanation.

## Developmental Program

### Grades 5-8

Cost \$335

For players who may be beginners or have had some middle school experience. There are 6 Sunday practices (2 hours each) and 2 Sunday Tournaments (3-4 hours each). Practices will take place at the Woodbridge and Westport locations only. The tournaments will be held at either the Woodbridge or Southern Connecticut State University facilities.

The emphasis of the Developmental Program is placed on developing a sound foundation of individual skills such as passing, serving, hitting and defense. Players are taken on a 1st registered basis as long as space permits. There are no tryouts! Registration deadline is January 1st. Practices are Jan. 4, 18 & 25, Feb. 8 & 22, Mar. 1. Tournaments are Feb. 1 & Mar. 8. The entire \$335 tuition must accompany the registration application.

### Fundraising Opportunities

The CJVA offers two fund-raising opportunities that help players pay for any CJVA program. The **CJVA Yearbook Advertisement Program** allows a player to use 90% of every ad they sell. Similar to a Walkathon, the **Servarama** allows players to collect sponsors for a special serving event to be held at their practice location. These programs work. Call the CJVA for more details.
